6.0 Specific FGG Policies

6.1 How will you address requirements of Policy guidelines for Age and Ability?

There are age and ability categories. Divisions may be removed or split by officials to ensure an optimal number of competitors.

6.2 How will you address requirements of Policy guidelines for Disability?

The venue is wheelchair-accessible. This sport is accessible, with a specific division for general mobility, lower-body mobility and visual impairment. This sport is accessible to players with hearing impairments.

6.3 How will you address requirements of Policy guidelines for Gender in Sport?

We will follow FGG gender policy standards. Legal-Male, Legal-Female or gender neutral. However, we will propose a women-only and a general category for this sport, too.

6.4 How will you address requirements of Policy guidelines for Health and Well- being, and in particular, Performance-Enhancing Drugs?

Building security and emergency medical staff will be present. Multiple age and ability divisions allows for competitors of various levels to excel. This decreases the incentive to use performance-enhancing drugs.

6.5 How will you address requirements of Policy guidelines for Officials?



Officials will be trained by an IAGLMA Judges
Certification Clinic that must take place during the
week of the Gay Games. Additional officials for specific
categories will be provided with the support of the
different national Martial Arts federations. They will be
suitably qualified to meet the Red Book requirements.

6.6 Will you be able to meet sport- specific Red Book requirements? What are the difficulties you foresee for meeting these requirements, and how will you deal with them? What gives you confidence that you will be able to respect Red Book requirements?

Yes, we will be able to meet the requirements of the Red Book for Martial Arts.
