

This is an urban, open space in València. A flat city with wide avenues, the streets will be adapted for the event. We will create a reception area for the athletes' registration, water stations and porta potties. Chaperones and spectators can watch the competition from various parts of the course, as well as from the finish area.

#### 6.2 How will you address requirements of Policy quidelines for Disability?


The circuit will be adapted for the use of specific bicycles for people with functional diversity. This sport is accessible to athletes with hearing impairments. Hand cycles are permitted.
