On a golf course there are no bleachers, the game is followed by accompanying one or several matches close by, or by staying at a certain hole and watching all the matches that take place there.

The golf courses have many changing rooms and lockers where players can store their belongings. They also have cafeterias and restaurants for getting a bite to eat or even having a meal. There are two training areas on the golf courses themselves.

2.6 Describe the venue with respect to the Red Book requirements. If the venue does not meet the Red Book requirements, what are your plans for dealing with this?

El Saler and El Bosque have 18 holes with minimum distances of 5.000 and 6.200 vards. The two courses together would give us a minimum of 36 holes.

2.7 What events are usually held in this venue?

Big competitions from the national and international golf calendar have taken place here.

2.8 Why did you choose this venue?

El Saler is one of the best courses in Europe and it also is the closest one to the city of València. El Bosque was designed by Robert Trent Jones Sr. and is one of the most interesting courses for playing golf in the region of Válencia.

If in the end both courses are used, we will have two shuttle bus services available throughout the whole
